## <u>US Mail</u>

This is the most secure method and probably the simplest. We recommend you use the addresses shown below as we did. Mail avoids the attempts by the bureau to sell you additional fee-laden protection services by telephone or website instead of a credit freeze.

This method is also the slowest.

WESCAP developed a general form (exhibiti xxx adapted from the Innovis form) for making a freeze request by mail. No cover letter is required, but you should put the name of the bureau on the form. Mailing this form is all that is required except as noted here:

<u>Firm</u>	<u>Requirements</u>
Innovis	Form only, no attachments
Experian	Form + copy of driver's license
Equifax	Form + copy of driver's license
Transunion	Form + copy of driver's license + copy of utility bill w/ name & address

Note that other forms of ID can be used. A driver's license shows both a government picture ID and home address.

## **Step-by-step Instructions**

- A. Fill out the form.
- B. Make four copies.
- C. Put name of specific bureau on each copy.
- D. Gather attachments required.
- E. Mail to respective bureaus using addresses above.
- F. Wait about 2 weeks for it to happen.
- G. Get PIN in mail or check to see if freeze is in place by calling phone number (above) and trying to place a credit freeze.
